V. Minimum wage

Missouri's minimum wage rose from \$7.50/hour to \$7.65/hour on 1/1/15 under a 2006 ballot measure providing for annual indexation of the state's minimum wage. (Federally covered employment and retail or service employers with gross annual sales of less than \$500,000 are exempted from the state's minimum wage requirements.)¹⁰ The same inflation adjustment applies to the state's tipped (or sub-minimum) wage rate, which increased from \$3.75/hour to \$3.83/hour. About six in ten of all minimum wage or belowminimum wage workers in Missouri are women.¹¹
