Virginia's minimum wage rate is at the federal level of \$7.25/hour, <sup>10</sup> as is its tipped (or subminimum) wage rate of \$2.13/hour. About two-thirds of all minimum wage or belowminimum wage workers in Virginia are women. <sup>11</sup>
