## What we do

### List-Based Technology and Models

Our programming is grounded in research. We run tests on everything from language to package design to responseprediction models. Thanks to this research, we know how and when to reach out individuals in the Rising American Electorate

#### **Quarterly Registration Programs**

• **Birthday:** Mail applications to 17 year-olds on the cusp of turning 18 and RAE members who have recently turned 18.

June projected response rate: 7.1%

- **Movers:** Mailed to RAE members previously registered at a former address. June projected response rate: 12.4%
- VAP: Mail applications universally to unregistered RAE.

June projected response rate: 4.0%

## Lists

#### **Benefits:**

- Near Universal Reach
- Highly Targeted, Model Based, Cost-Effective
- Controlled Studies Support Impact

#### **Challenges:**

No list is perfect, for instance:

- The SSA Master Death File is missing 1.2 million people.
- According to a recent Pew Center on the States report, 24 million (1-in-8) US registrations are invalid/inaccurate.


#### So we are doing even more to ensure our list quality.

- Excluding names that appear infrequently on the voter file
- Doubling Pet/Fake Names List
- Removing records were the first name is an initial
- Matching more broadly to the SSA Master Death File
- 13 Improvements to List Process that VPC initiated to improve vendor lists

#### **Registration and Voting Rates among Married and Unmarried Women**



### Currently, 47 million or 42% of the RAE is not registered to vote. That represents 63% of all unregistered Americans.

## September 2012 Mailing

The VPC and its partners will be sending out **4.3 million** registration applications in 28 states.

With our partner the League of Conservation Voters Education Fund, we will be sending vote by mail applications for absentee ballots to voters in 10 states.

We hope to generate approximately 800,000 applications from September of 2011 to September of 2012.




### Our Research Shows in Our Results.

Since September 2011, we and our partners have mailed nearly 7 million voter registration applications in 30 states.

#### Over 440,000 Americans have returned these applications.

Including: **89,000** African Americans **60,000** Latinos Over **175,000** young people



Adding "second notice" to envelope increased responses by 31%

Cost Per App: \$6.32


### Auto Calls Surprisingly Effective as Registration Reminders

- In February VPC pilot tested auto-call reminders in Wisconsin.
- In June VPC rolled over 600,000 reminder calls in 10 states.
- Early analysis shows reminder calls to be very cost-effective, especially for first-time mail targets who need a nudge.

- The VPC program will yield approximately **800,000** new registrants by Election Day!
- This will result in over **500,000** ballots cast by people who would otherwise be unable to vote.
- Maximizing turnout requires several kinds of tactics.
- Thanks to VPC's continuing experimentation, it can be more effective than ever.

# Cracking the Code: GOTV

• New Registrants and Unmarried Women Program

> Lower turnout for new registrants offers room for greatest impact, both short term and long term.

Promise Program

> Live phone calls to RAE members asking for commitment to vote. In 2007 test, increase turnout by 6%.

• Voting Survey:

>Test Live and Automated calls in survey designed to reinforce reasons to vote.
