## V. Minimum wage

South Dakota's minimum wage rate is $\$ 8.55 /$ hour under a 2014 ballot initiative, ${ }^{11}$ and its tipped (or sub-minimum) wage rate is $\$ 4.25 /$ hour. About half of all minimum wage or below-minimum wage workers in South Dakota are women. ${ }^{12}$
