### Minimum Wage

North Carolina's minimum wage rate is at the federal level of \$7.25/hour, 8 as is its tipped (or sub-minimum) wage rate of \$2.13/hour. Nearly seven in ten of all minimum wage or below-minimum wage workers in North Carolina are women. 9
